the US and in Canada, Scotland, Netherlands, Germany, France and Italy.

Susie and Calum have some 50+ years of Scottish Country Dancing experience between them and have performed for concerts, balls, summer camps and in biker bars in Queens.

As an added bonus, our weekend coincides with the Madison Celtic Festival. Weekend attendees may take advantage of Festival events during breaks in our schedule.

Weekend Overview

The weekend festivities begin with a Friday evening concert with Susie and Calum, featuring the best in Scottish music, old and new. To continue the revelry, stop by the UW Memorial Union after the concert and enjoy some Irish tunes by local bands.

Saturday's events include a morning dance workshop with Susie, two afternoon walkthroughs geared for beginning and advanced dancers, an evening social hour, dinner and ball, and after-ball party at a member's home. Celtic Festival events, also conveniently located at the UW Memorial Union, include an Irish dance demonstration at noon and concert by the Irish music group *Lunasa* at 4 pm.
